Most Christians know they should share their faith with others but very few do. Why? Two reasons: it's too embarrassing or uncomfortable and they have never been trained how. This workshop examines why people do not believe, what the spiritual and psychological obstacles are that prevent them from coming to faith in Christ. It also trains lay people in "relational evangelism," how to build the kinds of relationships that will open doors to spiritual discussions and sharing the Christian faith in ways that are non-threatening and comfortable for both parties.

This is a one hour workshop, with time for questions and discussion, that we have presented from coast to coast. The time frame makes it suitable for a Sunday morning adult forum but if more time is available the workshop can be longer.
